Go EAST on HWY. 219 (which is also Kiernan Road) past the signal at Fisk Rd. 1/3 miles (look for **CHP** building on the south side of highway at Stoddard St.) TURN RIGHT on **Stoddard St.**, turn right on **Technology Drive**, and turn right into **Scout Service Center** parking lot.

Be sure to have tire chains, winterized vehicle, and warm coat with you for this indoor session, in-preparation for outdoor session.

Bring camping gear so you can camp out over night on back lawn of Service Center if you wish.
